Subject: Participation in the Shelby County Republican Party

Fellow Shelby County Republicans:

Your Shelby County Republican Party (SCRP) is growing at an exciting rate, and we want you to become a more active participant. The Commonwealth's October voter-registration report reflects a total of 9,687 registered Republicans in Shelby County, which is a 230-person increase in just the past five months. By comparison, during that same period, our opposition increased by only 31 people. We are pleased that our growth is more than 700% of theirs, and we want to enlist your help in ensuring that this momentum leads our candidates to victory in the all-important 2010 elections.

We are living in a time of unprecedented threats to our liberty, and the Republican Party is committed to fighting for the values that have secured our freedom and way of life since the founding of our country. In 2010, we will have a full slate of conservative candidates seeking elected office at the city, county, state, and national levels, and to be fully effective, the SCRCP needs your help.
